

Teen Action & Support Center Program/Project Expectations

1. The **use or discussion of** drugs, alcohol, tobacco, vaping devices and/or weapons, while participating in TASC events, is ***strictly prohibited***.
2. All projects will be led by an adult supervisor (mentor). You are **required to check in and out with this person, and to remain in this person's presence** throughout the duration of the project unless otherwise directed.
3. ATTENDANCE POLICY: Your participation in this program is voluntary. Meaning, you choose to come to TASC for the activities for the entire two weeks. You may also choose to participate in any of our additional events by signing up on the Activity Calendar, or coming into our spaces. By choosing to attend projects with TASC, we ask for your *full commitment* to the projects you sign up for, which means that we plan that you will be attending and participating.
 - For BLS, If you are not able to keep your commitment or are running late, please promptly let us know by either texting us or calling our camp counselors (479.222.1764).
 - For other projects, we ask that you give us a **minimum of 24 hours notice** for cancellations, in order to allow time for someone else to sign up in your place.
 - Project reminder texts will be sent out prior to the start time of your project. At this time you must either **confirm or decline** your attendance.
 - **For BLS, if you know you can no longer participate in your assigned session please let us know ASAP so we may fill the spot with another teen from the waitlist.**
 - If you have **more than one no-call/no-show** to a project, are **continually late for dropoff or pick up**, or **miss more than one day of BLS we will remove you from BLS and/or projects** you have registered for and you will be placed on the waitlist for future activities.
4. For projects beyond BLS, special requirements, location details, date & time, and description of all projects and events are posted on our activity calendar at: tasenwa.org/calendar
5. Transportation to and from projects and events is sometimes provided. The Activity Calendar will always have details for event location, transportation availability, etc.
6. TASC practices confidentiality. Please respect the privacy of your peers during events and projects. Also, note, we are mandated reporters.
7. Disruptive behavior and/or disrespect will not be tolerated.

Failure to abide by expectations may result in one of the following actions:

1. Verbal conversation with adult supervisor
2. Dismissal from project and contact made with parents
3. Two week suspension from participating with TASC
4. Permanent dismissal from the TASC program(s)
